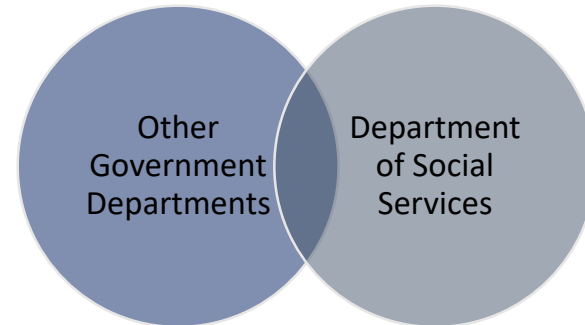
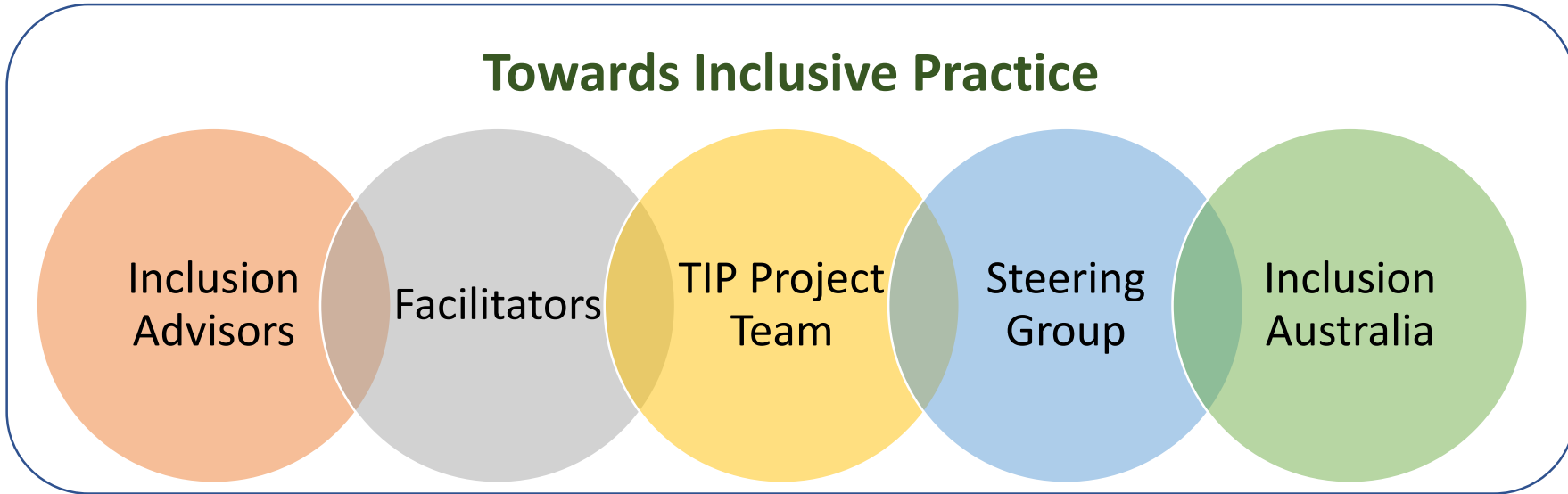


- It is important for government to listen to people with an intellectual disability

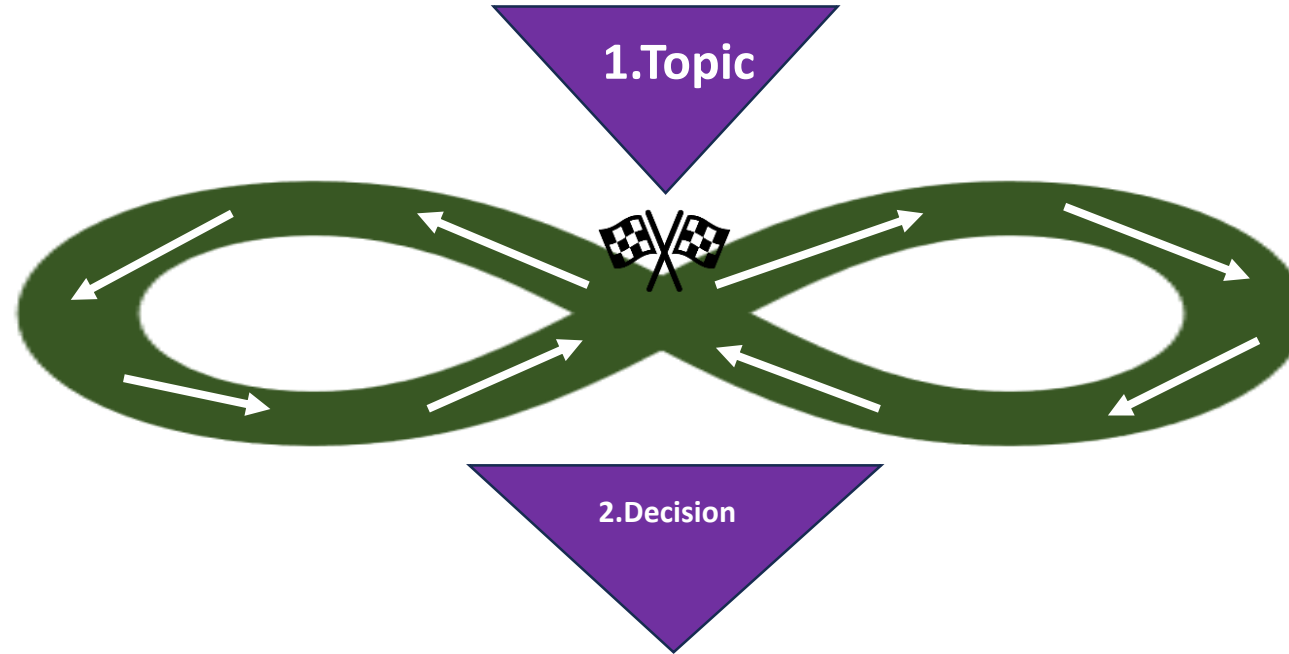

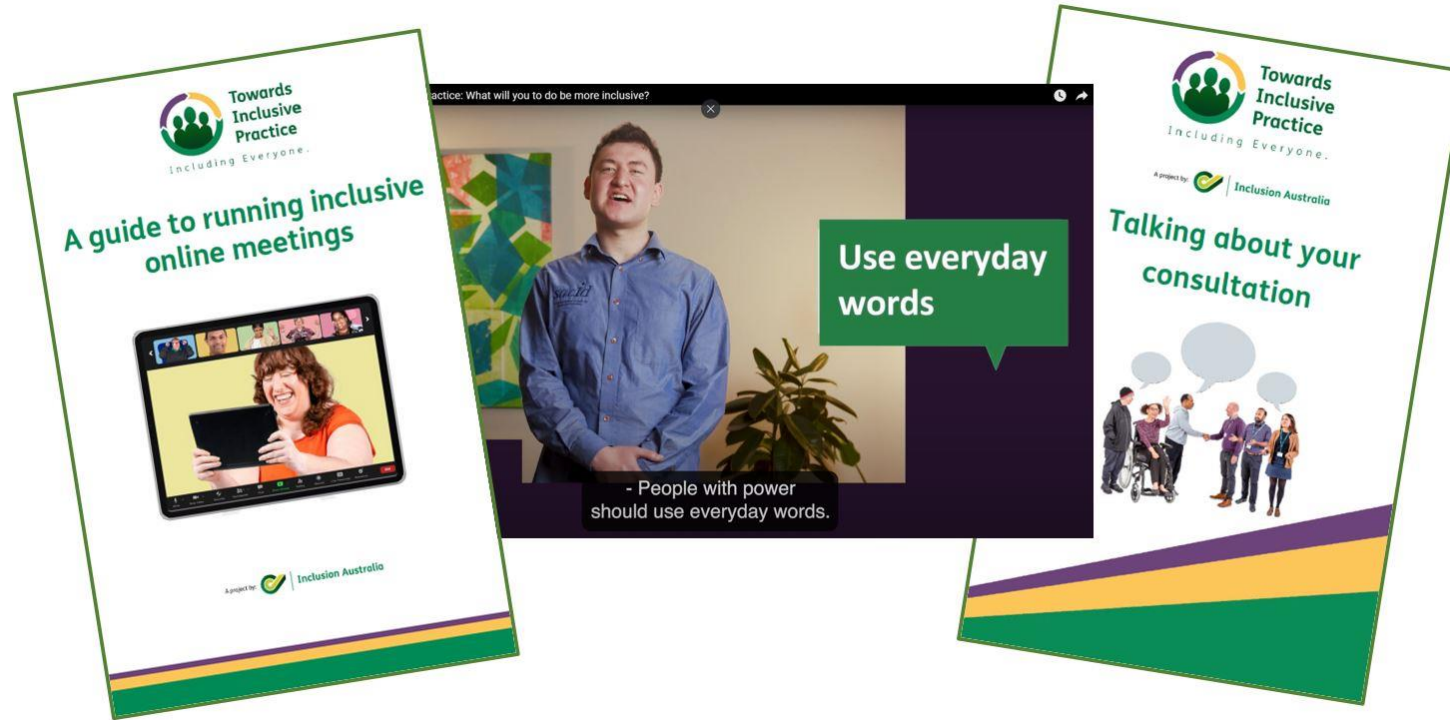
